What is WordPress? What is it for? What does it do?

WordPress began life a blogging system, but has developed into a full content management system with almost every widget plugin and theme you can imagine.

WordPress is used by over 13% of the 1,000,000 biggest websites.

As they say on their site "WordPress is limited only by your imagination".

This Course will enable you to build a basic WordPress site in a day. From adding pages and images to customizing widgets.

Who is this course for?

This course is for anyone who wants to be able to build their own website or blog using WordPress. Or for those who have already built as website using WordPress and want a structured training course to help them achieve more.

What do you need to start?

You will need a reasonable knowledge of the way websites work. If you have used Microsoft Word or similar word processing application to edit documents, this would be an advantage.

As long as your computer has the ability to access the Internet, any of today's Internet browsers will enable you to access and manipulate your WordPress Site.

In the future to run WordPress your website hosting provider just needs a couple of things:

- [PHP](#) version 4.3 or greater although many new plugins require PHP5
- [MySQL](#) version 4.1.2 or greater

The Venue

Computers and a WordPress training site are provided in a dedicated e-learning classroom, if pupils wish to bring their own laptop they may as a wireless network and electricity supply will be available.

What do you get?

This Course will enable you to build a basic WordPress Site in a Day. From adding pages and images to customizing widgets.
